277-437: Open Enrollment Policy

1. PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY

NUAMES Early College High School operates under an open admission policy. NUAMES is an equal opportunity provider and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, disability, or age in its programs and activities. NUAMES Early College High School staff collects names of prospective students, from school counselors, parents, civic organizations, etc., that align with the following criteria...

- 1.1 Under-represented in math, engineering, and science
- 1.2 Family operates at low socio-economic level as evidenced by free/reduced lunch eligibility
- 1.3 First member of family to attend college

2. RECRUITMENT

NUAMES Early College High School staff meets with the prospective students and parents in orientation meetings to provide a more complete picture of the process of applying to enroll at NUAMES.

Typically, students apply to enroll at the beginning of the students' tenth grade year, though applications for juniors and seniors are accepted as well. In addition, students and parents are informed that, in the event that they are selected to attend the following year, the students will be required to complete some academic testing to insure appropriate placement within some programs within NUAMES.

During these orientation meetings, the students are advised to consider their academic goals and needs to help them determine the degree to which NUAMES might be an appropriate option for their future educational plans.

If the number of applications exceeds the established student enrollment limit, then students will be chosen at random by a lottery from among the applicants.
