277-615: Student Searches

1. PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY

NUAMES enacts this policy in an effort to protect the safety, health, and security of NUAMES students, employees, and property.

2. Search and Seizure

School officials have the authority to search a student's person, personal property, or vehicle while located on school property or at a school sponsored activity, when they have reason to believe that the search will turn up evidence that the student has violated or is violating a particular law or school rule.

Students have no right or expectation of privacy on campus. Periodic general inspections, including the use of drug detecting canines, may be conducted by school authorities for any reason at any time, without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant.
