Concurrent enrollment information from Ms. Lori Drake:

As of Friday, August 26, all of our students will have received information about Concurrent Enrollment (CE). Please note that there is an admissions process first, THEN registration for their course. Once a student is admitted to the college offering the credit, they will never have to pay the admissions fee again. We offer Concurrent Enrollment classes through Weber State University, Salt Lake Community College, and Utah State. Although WSU is our partner school, they don't always offer the courses we want to offer. Therefore we must go through these other two universities. If a student has already been admitted, they can register for their course using their instruction sheet given to them in class and their Course Registration Number (CRN). Please make sure you and your student have signed the green 2016-17 Concurrent Enrollment Student Participation Form and that it is returned to the Concurrent Enrollment teacher. This form should be returned with the teacher's disclosures. The deadlines will be on the Concurrent Enrollment Forms given to the student by the teachers.

Concurrent Enrollment is such a great opportunity for our students to earn college credit, but please remember, the grade they earn in their NUAMES class is the grade that will show up on their college transcript.

A reminder: All NUAMES students must be enrolled at Weber State...this is what will give them the ability to log in on our computers!

THE PSAT/NMSQT will be given at NUAMES on Wednesday, October 19 from 8 am to noon on our campus. This is the qualifying exam for the National Merit Scholar Program and is great practice for the SAT and the ACT. The cost is \$15 and you pay for this in the office. **The deadline for payment is Sept. 21.** Sophomores take this test for practice and juniors take it for the National Merit competition.
